Youth Fundraiser

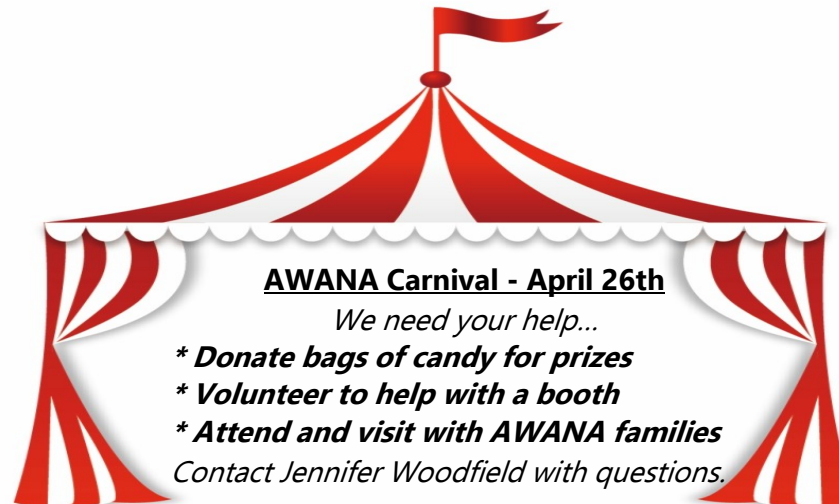
