God has moved as they opened a small refugee center to help with the large influx of Ukrainian refugees which connected them to hundreds of new people. It was a great opportunity to touch lives for Christ and witness in their community. Since then, three new Ukrainian churches have been started, and their church has grown and been constituted as an official church in the Polish Baptist Union.
