### LAKE SERVICE - TONIGHT (weather permitting)

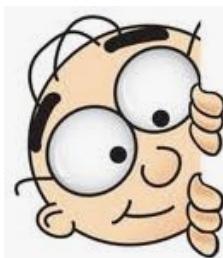
*LOBCers are invited to join together for a great time of fellowship and worship at Twin Creek Campground.*
