In a recent update Franklin Graham shared how medical missions have long been a crucial part of the work of Samaritan's Purse. Today there are 110 physicians on the foreign mission field in this program. He told about one missionary still serving, Dr. Seth Mallay and his daughter, Arwen. Arwen had cancer and they returned home to Michigan for treatment.
