### How do you become a born-again follower of Christ?

Understand that God is Almighty Creator, Supreme Lord of the Universe. He is Holy, and as such has Exceptionally High Standards.

*Because that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them. For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse. Romans 1:19-20*

We humans have broken God's standards and rebelled against Him. This is called sin.

- ◇ *For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. Romans 3:23*
- ◇ *For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23*

God loves you so much that He sent His Son, Jesus to pay the price for your sin by dying on the cross and then, Jesus rose from the dead in victory and power over death. To receive this gift of salvation... confess you are a sinner, ask Him for forgiveness, then surrender your life to following Jesus as Lord.

- ◇ *But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8*
- ◇ *That if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation. Romans 10:9-10*
