MISSION MOMENT

The Annie Armstrong offering supports church planters. David and Sarah Gaskins planted a church in the hub of the worldwide Mormon Church in Provo, Utah. "Planting a church here is obviously a tall order," says David. "But we love Mormons and want them to believe in the real Jesus. That's why we came." The congregation made up largely of young, one-time Mormons who are paying a price for their response to the gospel. "When somebody here leaves the Mormon church, it's a really big deal," says David. "They lose their job. They get shunned by their family. This church is all they have. They've found the real Jesus, and they're never going back."
